PETITION FOR NATURALIZATION

To the Honorable the Circuit Court of Alleghany County at Cumberland, Md
 The petition of Ralph Nery hereby filed, respectfully sheweth:
 First. My place of residence is 30 Lombard St, Cumberland, Md
 Second. My occupation is Merchant
 Third. I was born on the 10 day of April, anno Domini 1889, at Parma, Italy
 Fourth. I emigrated to the United States from Havre, France, on or about the 28 day of April
 anno Domini 1906, and arrived in the United States, at the port of New York, on the 6 day of May
 anno Domini 1906, on the vessel Lorraine
 (If the alien arrived otherwise than by vessel, the character of conveyance or name of transportation company should be given.)
 Fifth. I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on the 16 day of December, anno Domini 1915
 at Ebensburg, Pennsylvania in the Common Pleas Court of Cambria County, Pa
 Sixth. I am married. My wife's name is Emmilia Nery; she was born on the 26 day of October, anno Domini 1898
 at Caprina, Italy, and now resides at 30 Lombard St, Cumberland, Md
 (Give number, street, city or town, and State.)
 I have 2 children, and the name, date and place of birth, and place of residence of each of said children is as follows:
Inis, born June 16, 1917, at Cumberland, Md.
Alfred, born Feb. 29, 1919, " " and both live
in Cumberland, Md with Parents.

Seventh. I am not a disbeliever in or opposed to organized government or a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching disbelief in or opposed to organized government. I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy. I am attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and it is my intention to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Victor Emmanuel III, King of Italy of whom at this time I am a subject, and it is my intention to reside permanently in the United States.

Eighth. I am able to speak the English language.

Ninth. I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of five years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since the 6 day of May, anno Domini 1906, and in the State of Maryland, continuously next preceding the date of this petition, since the 3 day of January, anno Domini 1916, being a residence within this State of at least one year next preceding the date of this petition.

Tenth. I have not heretofore made petition for citizenship to any court. (I made petition for citizenship to the _____ Court of _____ at _____, on the _____ day of _____, anno Domini 1____, and the said petition was denied by the said Court for the following reasons and causes, to wit: _____, and the cause of such denial has since been cured or removed.)

Attached hereto and made a part of this petition is my declaration of intention to become a citizen of the United States and the certificate from the Department of Labor, together with my affidavit and the affidavits of the two verifying witnesses thereto, required by law. Wherefore your petitioner prays that he may be admitted a citizen of the United States of America.
